NOTE: IRCA will NOT accept audits conducted to the respective ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 14001:2015 Standards versions until AFTER the transition training course modules been successfully completed.

It is essential for Certified Auditors of ALL GRADES to sit these transition courses if there is a desire to continue IRCA auditor certification status.

Overview

This 1-Day ISO 14001:2015 Auditor Transition course offered by Ashbrooke introduces to delegates the revised ISO 14001 document with the focus on changes from ISO 14001:2004 to ISO 14001:2015.

The course examines this document with a general overall look at the changes in play. This is supported with discussing its components throughout the course.
